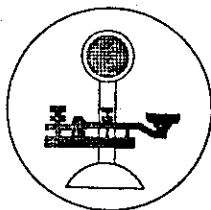

MINUTES OF THE AUGUST, 1984  
GENERAL MEETING

(SUBJECT TO APPROVAL AT THE SEPTEMBER MEETING)

THE GENERAL CLUB MEETING WAS HELD ON AUGUST 1, 1984 AT THE EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER OF THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATION COMPLEX AND WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 7:32 P.M. BY OUR PRESIDENT, JIM, W6CYM.

THE FOLLOWING VISITOR WAS INTRODUCED: KB6FOT, DONNA.

A NEW NOVICE WAS INTRODUCED: HELEN, YL OF W6CYM, JIM, IS AWAITING HER CALL SIGN HAVING JUST PASSED THE NOVICE EXAM.

STANDING BUSINESS

THE MINUTES OF THE JULY MEETING WERE APPROVED (MOVED BY W6JXZ, SECONDED BY W6GRNF, VOTED BY THE CLUB).

COMMUNICATIONS RECEIVED WERE: 1) A LETTER FROM THE ARRL GRANTING OUR SPECIAL SERVICE CLUB STATUS; 2) A LETTER FROM THE ARRL CONCERNING THE VE AT THE CONVENTION ON SEPTEMBER 1; 3) A LETTER FROM W6DTV, HANK, EXPLAINING THE AUTOMATIC REPEATER IDENTIFYING LAW AND REQUIREMENTS; 4) A LETTER FROM W6DTV, HANK, RESIGNING AS EDITOR OF SHORT SKIP AT THE END OF THIS YEAR; AND 5) A LETTER FROM THE UNABILLA COMPANY OFFERING AT 10% DISCOUNT IF YOU MENTION YOUR CLUB NAME WHEN ORDERING.

TREASURER'S REPORT WAS AS FOLLOWS: GENERAL FUND - BEGINNING BALANCE WAS \$544.36; ENDING BALANCE WAS \$452.78. REPEATER FUND REMAINED UNCHANGED AT \$1,433.25 (MOVED BY KD6GC, SECONDED BY W6SNY, VOTED BY THE CLUB)

THE REPEATER COMMITTEE REPORTED THAT THE OLD GENERAL ELECTRIC WAS REMOVED AND THE REVCO WAS NOW IN OPERATION ON THE HILL. IT NEEDED SOME WORK BUT WAS NOW ALRIGHT. THE CONTROL RECEIVER IS WORKING. IT IS PUTTING OUT 35 WATES (ABOUT 1/2 THE POWER FTHE GE). WE HAVE NOT BEEN ABLE TO CONTACT THE RED CROSS YET ABOUT THE SALE OF THE 6-METER REPEATER, BUT THEY ARE PLANNING TO PURCHASE IT, AS IS, FOR \$300.

EDUCATION COMMITTEE IS PLANNING TO BEGIN ANOTHER NOVICE CLASS THE END OF SEPTEMBER. IT WILL PROBABLY BE HELD ON THURSDAY NIGHT AGAIN. ALSO, AN UP-GRADE CLASS WILL BE HELD AT THE SAME TIME. INTERESTED PEOPLE WILL BE ABLE TO SIGN UP FOR THESE CLASSES AT THE FLEA MARKET OR THEY CAN CONTACT NIAL, AL, OR KS6W, GEORGE.

ACTIVITIES COMMITTEE:

1) THE CLUB PICNIC IN HONOR OF W6GRNF, WARREN, WAS A BIG SUCCESS. KS6W, GEORGE, WON THE CHILI CONTEST WITH W6GRNF, TERRY, COMING IN SECOND. A GREAT TIME WAS HAD BY ALL WHO ATTENDED.

2) THE ACAPULCO BRUNCH WILL BE HELD ON SUNDAY, AUGUST 19, AT 1 P.M. COST IS \$7.50, ADULTS; \$3.50, CHILDREN. BRING THE WHOLE FAMILY AND JOIN THE FUN.

3) THE MARQUEE FUND RAISER WILL BE HELD ON SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 30, AT 2 P.M. WE HAVE TICKETS FOR 42 TABLES. THERE ARE STILL TICKETS AVAILABLE FOR 17 OF THE TABLES. WE NEED CLUB MEMBERS TO TAKE THESE AND SELL THEM TO FRIENDS, CO-WORKERS, RELATIVES, ETC. LET'S ALL MAKE AN EXTRA EFFORT. REMEMBER THE ONE WHO SELLS THE MOST TICKETS GETS TWO FREE!

4) COMMUNICATIONS WERE PROVIDED FOR A 10K RUN ON TUESDAY, JULY 31, FOR WORLD HUNGER. WE WERE ABLE TO INITIATE SOME NEW HAMS WITH SEASONED HAMS HELPING. THE WALK ITSELF WAS VERY DISORGANIZED BUT WE DID OUR PART SUPERBLY. THIS WAS THE FIRST OFFICIAL EVENT HELD BY ARES. IN THE FUTURE WE WILL TRY TO MIX INEXPERIENCED HAMS WITH THOSE WHO HAVE DONE IT BEFORE SO AS TO GIVE AS MANY AS POSSIBLE EXPERIENCE.

RADIO PARTS WILL BE AVAILABLE FROM W66FY, VAN, ON MONDAY, AUGUST 6. ANYTHING NOT SOLD THEN WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE FLEA MARKET AT A HIGHER PRICE.

OLD BUSINESS

THE FLEA MARKET WILL BE HELD ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 15. THERE HAVE BEEN 170 ANNOUNCEMENT LETTERS SENT OUT WITH APPROXIMATELY TWO-THIRDS OF THOSE GOING TO CLUBS AND ONE-THIRD TO HAM RADIO BUSINESSES. A POSTER WILL BE PUBLISHED IN SHORT SKIP. TAKE IT OUT AND POST IT. IF YOU NEED MORE, THEY WILL BE AVAILABLE. THE RENTAL FEE FOR THE SEBASTOPOL COMMUNITY CENTER IS \$125 + \$100 (DEPOSIT, CLEANING). (MOVED BY W6GRNF, SECONDED BY W6JRB, VOTED BY THE CLUB). THE SIGN-UP SHEET WAS PASSED AROUND AGAIN. VOLUNTEERS ARE STILL NEEDED IN MOST AREAS. BOTH THE DIRECTOR AND SECTION MANAGER HAVE BEEN INVITED TO ATTEND. FCC EXAMS WILL BE GIVEN, TECHNICIAN THROUGH EXTRA. AUGUST 20 IS THE DEADLINE FOR REGISTERING. YOU WILL NEED TO FILL OUT A 610 FORM, SEND A CHECK FOR \$4.00 (MADE OUT TO ARRL/VEC), AND A COPY OF YOUR LICENSE. SEND THESE TO W6DTV, HANK.

THE SONOMA FLEA MARKET WILL BE HELD ON SUNDAY, AUGUST 12, AT THE COMMUNITY CENTER ON EAST NAPA STREET IN SONOMA.

NEW BUSINESS

ROLL CALL PROCEDURE ON THE TUESDAY NIGHT NET HAS BEEN CHANGED TO AN ALPHABETICAL GROUPING RATHER THAN THE INDIVIDUAL CALL METHOD. THE CLUB WAS ASKED ITS FEELINGS ON THE MATTER AND IT WAS ABOUT 50-50. WA0JRB, DOUG, WILL PREPARE A SURVEY TO BE INCLUDED IN THE NEXT ISSUE OF SHORT SKIP ASKING THE CLUB MEMBERS WHAT THEY WOULD LIKE TO HAVE DONE ON THE NET.

THE PROGRAM WAS MOST INFORMATIVE AND INTERESTING.

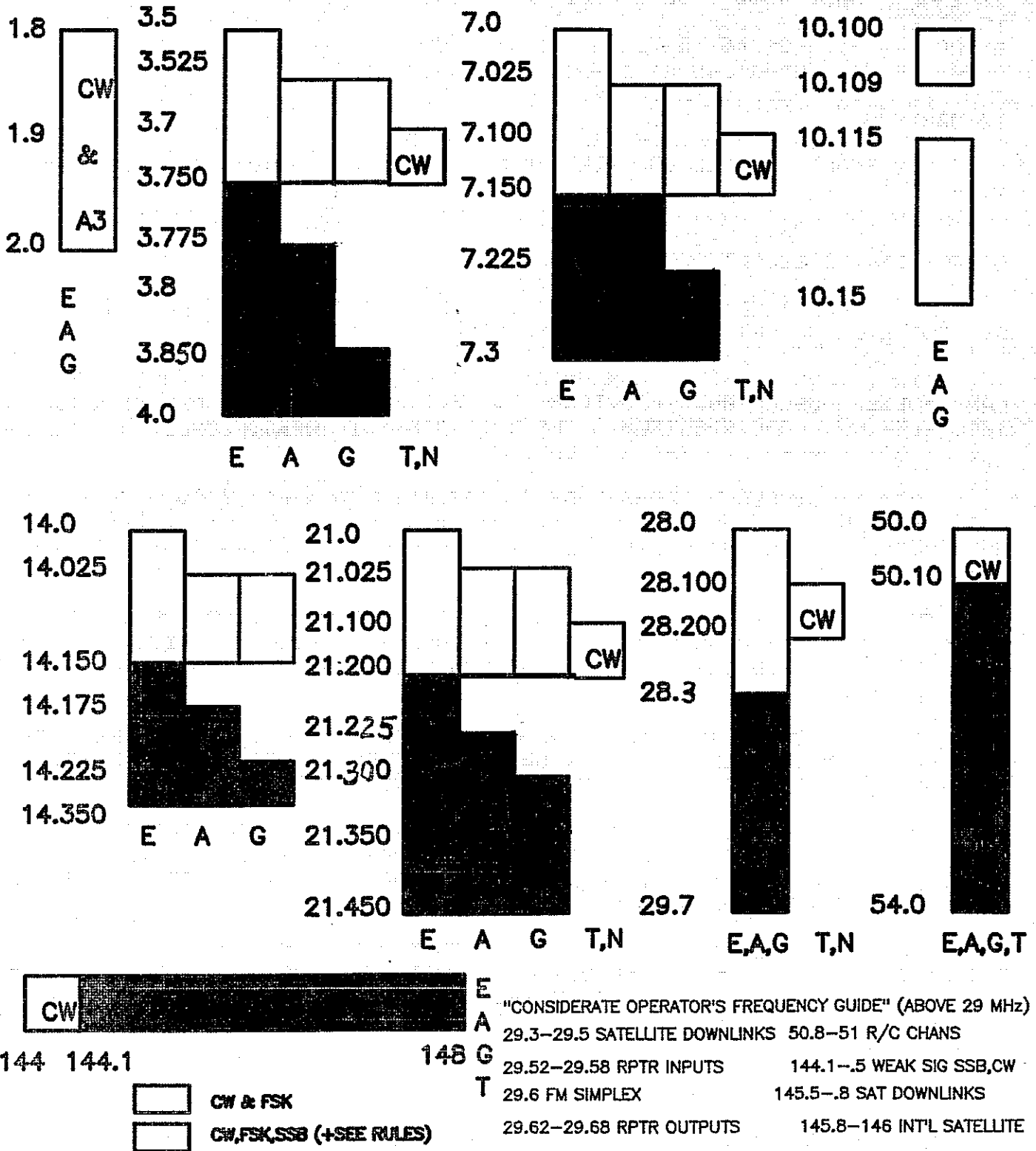

SOURCE OF THE RECENT 220 ANXIETY....

THE CURRENT CONCERN FOR THE FUTURE OF THE 220-225 MHZ TOUCHED OFF BY FOUR EVENTS THAT HAPPENED VERY RECENTLY.

FIRST--LAND MOBILE COMMUNICATIONS COUNCIL, A NON PROFIT ASSN. OF LAND MOBILE USERS AND PROVIDERS OF SERVICES FILED A PETITION ON JUNE 18TH SEEKING MORE SPECTRUM. THE LMCC DID NOT SPECIFICALLY ASK FOR THE 220MHZ HAM BANK--ONLY THE FCC CONSIDERED IT.

SECOND--SIDEBAND TECHNOLOGY, INC SUBMITTED A PETITION FOR SPECTRUM REALLOCATION, ASKING FOR 6 MHZ OF SPECTRUM FOR EXCLUSIVE USE BY NARROWBAND TRANSMISSION SYSTEMS, IN THE LMCC. THIS WAS FROM 216 TO 222 MHZ.

THIRD--STI FILED AN ADDENDUM TO THE ABOVE GIVING THE USE BETWEEN 216 AND 225 MHZ--THESE CHARTS CLEARLY SHOW SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITY BETWEEN 216 AND 220 AND 222 AND 225 MHZ. VIRTUALLY NONE BETWEEN 220 AND 222 MHZ.

FOURTH--FCC AT ARRL NATIONAL CONVENTION PUBLICLY ACKNOWLEDGED THAT THEY WERE INDEED EXPLORING AN OPTION THAT COULD REALLOCATE AMATEUR 220 MHZ BAND SPECTRUM TO ACCOMODATE THE EVER INCREASING LMCC NEEDS.

LMCC IS COMPOSEDD OF--COMMON CARRIER, PUBLIC SAFETY, APSCO, ELECTRONIC INDUSTRIES ASSN., TRUCKING, AMER. PETROL. INST., AAA, ASSN. OF FIRE CHIEFS, TAXICABS, NABER, RAILROADS, JUST A FEW. THIS SHOWS MONEY? WHERE WILL THE HAMS END UP?

THE LMCC PETITION SHOWS A NEED FOR 32 MHZ OF SPECTRUM AND SUGGESTED THAT THE COMMISSION PERMIT THE USE OF THE 800 MHZ FREQUENCIES. IT IS NOTED THAT THE 902-928 MHZ BAND IS ALSO A LMCC SHARED BAND AND HAMS MAY NEVER SEE THAT AREA. I HOPE WE DONT LOOSE EVERYTHING, KEEP YOUR EYES OPEN.

COMM. ACT REWRITE AFFECTS JAMMERS..

A PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE COMMUNICATIONS ACT OF 1934 COULD PUT JAMMERS IN JAIL. THIS BILL WOULD AMEND THE ACT TO MAKE WILLFUL AND MALICIOUS INTERFERENCE A CRIMINAL OFFENSE, RATHER THAN JUST THE ADMINISTRATIVE VIOLATION THAT IT IS NOW. KEEP AN EYE ON THIS ONE.
