Bill and I later corresponded and pretty soon he was settled in San Antonio, married, with a child on the way. Inevitably, a house and ham station were in the works, too. Bill had been described to me as a "born operator," from his earliest teen-age activity as N5BET.

On October 27, 1991, KM5R was completing his operation in the CQ Worldwide DX Phone Contest. There was a problem with one of the antennas on his 60-foot tower.

"You know how these radio guys are," his wife Cindy says. "Something doesn't work right and they need to fix it. Right

Bill Carter climbed his tower, without a climbing belt, and fell. He was taken immediately to a hospital, but he never regained consciousness and died two weeks later, on November

In addition to his wife, Bill Carter leaves a 2-year-old son, Alex, and many Amateur Radio friends, including at least one in Connecticut. — K1TN. The ARRL Letter
