In order that SIRARC operating Rules and Procedures are within the limits required by our Parent Organization, Sons In Retirement, Inc., and the requirements of the F.C.C., it has been mutually agreed by the Executive Committee of Sons In Retirement, Inc., and the Executive Committee of SIRARC to amend Rule No. 1. Rule No. 1 was amended on October 7, 1982, to read as follows:

Membership in SIRARC (Sir's Amateur Radio Club) is open only to members of Sons In Retirement, Inc., who hold current Amateur Radio Licenses.

An active SIRARC member who loses his qualifications to remain a member of SONS IN RETIREMENT, INC., will no longer be qualified for membership in SIRARC. He may, however, at the discretion of the Executive Board of SIRARC and by vote of the membership, be awarded the title of ASSOCIATE KEY.

Any person who has rendered outstanding technical, scientific or professional service to SIRARC may, at the discretion of the Executive Board of SIRARC and by vote of the membership, be awarded the title of HONORARY KEY.

Rules 2, 3, 4 and 5 remain unchanged as quoted on pages 9 and 10.

In view of the above, the Executive Committee agreed that ASSOCIATE and HONORARY KEYS may:

1. Continue their participation in our nets, a privilege provided for in F.C.C. Rules and Regulations.
2. Have his affiliation known by future members of above participation.
3. Be retained on the SIRARC Roster and Check List, under the above titles, for the ready convenience of all participating in SIRARC nets.

Claude was born on March 4, 1906, in Detroit, Michigan. He lost his Mother two days later and was cared for by his Grandmother until he was 14 years old, at which time she passed away.

EDUCATION AND PROFESSIONAL CAREER:

His elementary education began in Steamboat, Colorado; continued in Detroit, Virginia and finally Minnesota, where he attended Mt. Iron High School. After graduation, he served a four-year Apprenticeship as a Tool and Die Maker in Duluth, Minnesota.

In 1940 Claude moved to California to work for Hall-Scott Motor Car Company in Berkeley, building VL2 Motors for the Navy during WWII. After the war he went to work for the University of California Radiation Laboratory in Berkeley as a Tool Maker. He later transferred to work under Louis Alveraz as a Research Technologist and had the good fortune of being with the group when Dr. Alveraz received the Nobel Prize in Physics. He retired from the Radiation Laboratory with 25 years service.

FAMILY DATA:

Claude married Merie I. Lkola on May 27, 1927. He and Merie live in Walnut Creek, California. They have one married son, Bob, who holds an Advance-Class License, WB6LKZ.

RADIO ACTIVITIES:

Claude first became interested in radio while in grade school and money did not come easily, but he managed to scrape enough together to build a few receivers during those years, progressing from crystal sets to an eight-tube Super Hetrodyne. Being newly married during the depression years of the 1930's, he found little time or money to continue his hobby. The interest lay dormant

until 1975, when he learned that the Mt. Diablo Radio Club had free classes to assist interested individuals in acquiring a Novice License. He became a member of SIRARC June 11, 1975, and now holds a General-Class Ticket.

OTHER HOBBIES AND INTERESTS:

Claude learned to fly while in Minnesota and for a period of time after he came to California he flew for the Civil Air Patrol on search and rescue missions up and down the coast and as far east as the Sierras.

He is also interested in Model Railroading, Boating, Fishing and Super 8 Movie Photography.
